

Kiitosimeon to purchase Kuljetus Mankinen Oy

Kiitosimeon Oy and Kuljetus Mankinen Oy have signed a purchase contract with which all of the business activity of Mankinen Oy transfers to Kiitosimeon Oy on the 1st of June, 2020.

Kuljetus Mankinen Oy is a 1957 established family company situated in Hamina. Mankinen Oy transports liquid and gas products, with 12 articulated vehicles, in Finland, Sweden and Norway. Yearly turnover of the company's business activity is 3 million euros which brings Kiitosimeon's yearly turnover to over 70 million euros.
